3. Provide documentation of your use of Google Earth PRO in the form of KML files, videos, lesson plans, or testimony.

 - Examples: Undergraduates, High School Students, Faculty, Staff
- List of PRO features anticipated to be used and how they would be used
 - Examples: MovieMaker, Import Datasets, Image Export
- Description of how, when and in what format documentation of your PRO work will be submitted
- Number of PRO installations requested
- IMPORTANT: If previously held a Google Earth trial account, provide your user name & license key.
